# **SPARK Equity Awards Instructions**

# **Organization Submissions**

#### 1. How To Apply

- Applications will be accepted December 1, 2025 through February 25th, 2026.
- Read all of the grant information and options for resources to be funded.
- Complete the online application form: 2026 SPARK Equity Awards Application Form- Organizations
- Watch the SPARK Equity Grants Webinar video for additional information and explanation.
- You may only submit 1 application per school/organization.

#### 2. Eligibility

The School of Exercise and Nutritional Sciences at San Diego State University is looking to award funding to districts/organizations who serve students/youth in low-income and underserved communities. Eligible applicants include:

- Public/private school districts.
- Organizations that provide physical activity for youth.
- Organizations who were not awarded a SPARK Equity Award the previous year.

#### 3. Selection Criteria

The goal of the SPARK Equity Grants is to provide resources to support as many students/youth and programs as possible. The committee will evaluate applications based on:

- Needs of the district/organization/students/community.
- Ability to effectively implement the SPARK program.
- Number of students/youth that will be directly impacted.
- The amount of money requested per student served.

#### 4. Available Funding

- The foundation will distribute \$140,000 to awardees, including both individuals and organizations.
- There is not a limit on the amount the organizations can apply for in your application. As a reminder, the goal of the equity awards is to support as many students/youth and programs as possible. Please keep this in mind as you choose the resources that you include in your request for funding as it is a priority to choose multiple deserving organizations.
- Those awarded grant funding will not be receiving a check or money the award is for the "goods & services", paid for by the School of Exercise and Nutritional Sciences at San Diego State University.

### **5. Awarding Recipients**

- A review team with expertise in SPARK programs, childhood physical activity, and health equity will rate the eligibility, documentation of need, and responses to the application items.
- Winners will be announced by April 6, 2026 on the SPARK website and social media.
- All applicants (funded or not) will be notified by email.
- Award recipients will be asked to complete a short survey after using the SPARK materials and are encouraged to post about their program implementation and successes on social media.

#### 6. SPARK Resource Bundles

- In Section 3 of the SPARK Equity Grants Application Form, you will request the resources you need.
- Below is the list of options for each SPARK program and the value of the resources for each area.
- Use this information to decide what resources you need and how much funding you will apply for.
- You must request curriculum, but equipment and professional development are optional.
